## FUEL RELATED SURCHARGE

**APPLICATION-**

All rates and charges, except where contractually prohibited, or accessorial charges for services that do not consume fuel, are hereby increased as shown below:

When the U.S. National Average Fuel Index equals or exceeds \$1.75 per gallon, the fuel surcharge continues to increase 0.5% for every five cent increase in fuel price.

**COMPUTATION-**

Determine the applicable net charge. Multiply the net charge by the percentage as provided for in the Table listed below. The resultant fuel surcharge will **Not** be subject to discount or adjustment.

Fractions of less than one half cent will be dropped. Fractions of one half cent or greater will be increased to the next whole cent.

**HANDLING FREIGHT AT POSITIONS NOT IMMEDIATELY ADJACENT TO VEHICLE (INSIDE PICK-UP AND DELIVERY)**

When requested by consignor or consignee, and conditions permit, the carrier may move shipments from or to positions beyond the immediately adjacent loading or unloading positions as defined in Item 750 (Pick-Up or Delivery of Freight). Such service will be performed to floors above or below the level accessible to the carrier's vehicle only when elevator or escalator service is available at no cost to the carrier, including the labor to operate same where necessary.

- a) When the carrier is requested to perform inside pick-up or delivery or to uncarton or place merchandise, such service will be performed, subject to charge of **\$8.90** per one hundred (100) pounds, subject to a minimum charge of **\$39.00** per shipment with a maximum charge of **\$500.00**.
- b) Upon request by shipper or consignee, carrier will perform inside pick up or delivery above or below street level where no elevator service is available, thereby requiring hand carrying, for which an additional charge of **\$10.00** per floor per shipment. When such service requires the services of additional persons, in addition to the driver of the vehicle, there will be an additional charge of **\$50.00** per hour subject to a maximum charge of **\$100.00**. These charges will be addition to all other lawful charges.
